Building Stairways

SUMMARY
Building stairways, during the construction process, can be very hazardous. Lack of elevator availability or limited access to the elevator may lead to heavy foot traffic on stairways.

THINGS TO CONSIDER
*All railings are in place before the stairway is opened for use. Landings with open sides need standard guardrails for proper fall protection. The stairs need handrails for workers to hold when ascending or descending. Keep the stairway clear to reduce the likelihood of slips, trips, or falls. Do not store tools or construction materials on the stairway. Do not shove tools down on the stairway. Clean up any liquid spills or snow/ice immediately. There is adequate lighting at the stairway. Adequate lighting can be a problem since permanent lighting is usually installed after the stairway construction is completed. OSHA construction standards require five foot-candles of light in stairways. A standard light meter measures the amount of light. Install a temporary light bulb string in the stairway if the light is inadequate. Each bulb is equipped with a protective cover. Inspect the light string daily for burned out or broken bulbs. Try to avoid using the stairway for transporting materials between floors. Carrying small materials and tools is fine as long as the materials do not block your vision. Trying to go up or down a stairway while carrying large items is physically demanding. It also increases your potential for a strain or sprain injury as well as a fall. Having a co-worker to help you carry the load may reduce your exposure to strain, but it may increase the exposure for both of you to be involved in a slip or fall accident. The best alternative is to use the building elevator or crane service.

WHO IS IT IMPORTANT?
If special attention is not given to safety considerations on stairways, accidents during usage are likely to occur.

Chemical Hazards

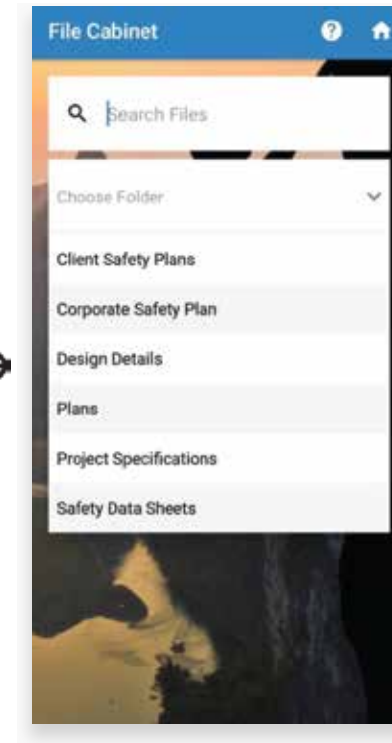
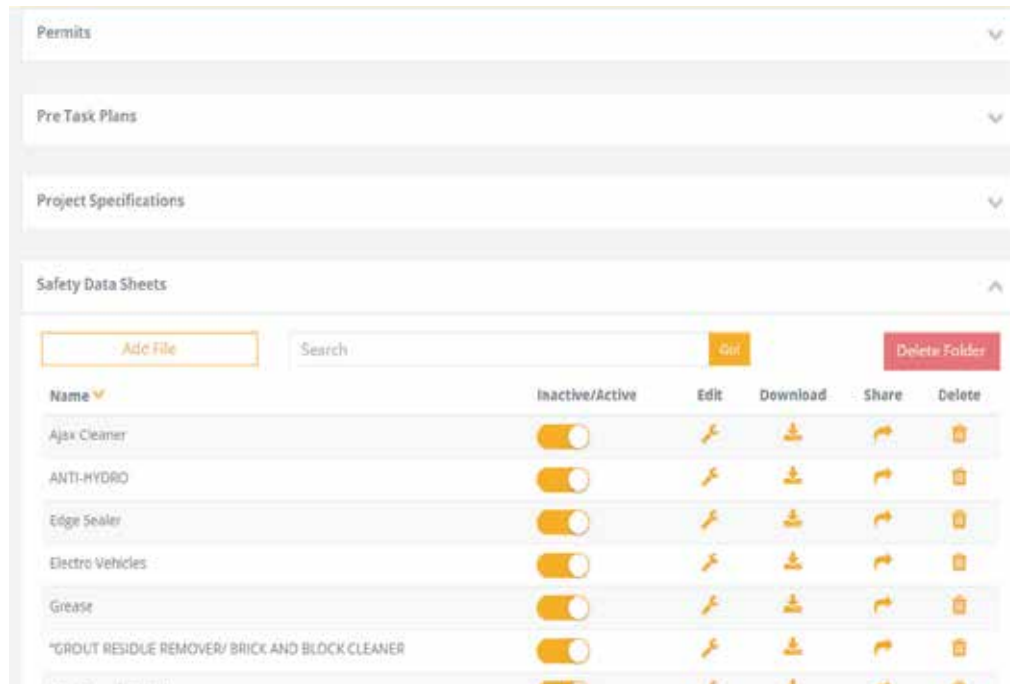
Summary
Chemicals have become an important part of the industrial environment and our everyday lives. Many of these chemicals contain ingredients or are by themselves, harmful to humans. The U. S. Department of Labor - Occupational Safety and Health
Administration (OSHA) has recognized the problems associated with chemicals and has issued a standard, which helps employees become aware of the chemical hazards in their workplace. This standard requires the labeling of chemicals by both the manufacturer and importer and by the employer; the standard requires that employees receive information and training regarding the chemicals used in the workplace; and a written program regarding chemical hazards.
The total requirements can be found in the OSHA Standards for General Industry (29 CFR 1910.1200) and Construction Standard (1926.59).

Why is this important?
*Applicability - This standard applies to any hazardous chemical, which is present in the workplace in such a manner that employees may be exposed under normal conditions or foreseeable emergencies.
Manufacturers and importers are required to provide industrial users with information regarding the chemicals they provide. This information is

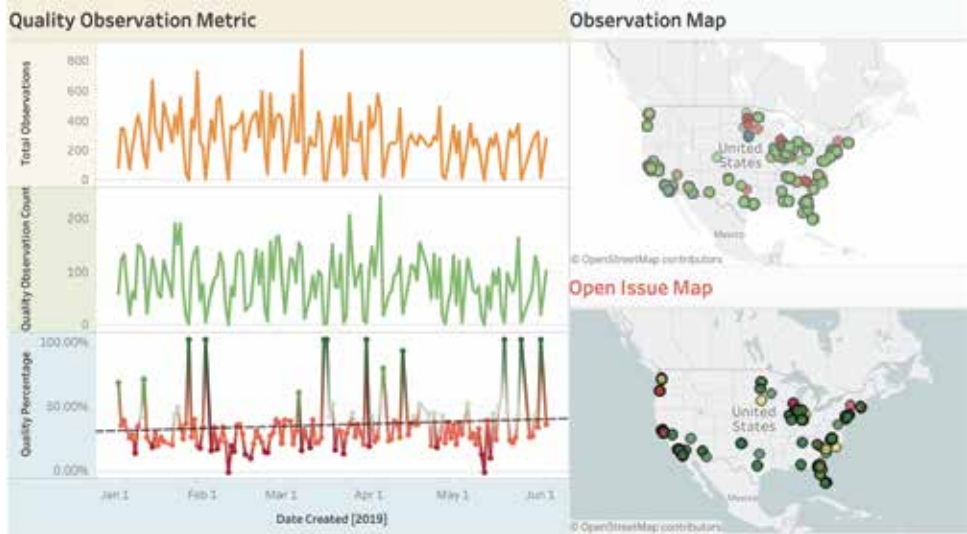

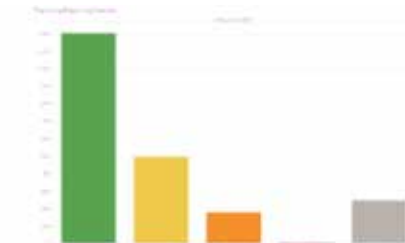
